

GRAVEL ROAD MAINTENANCE WORKSHOP

John Maclaine of the Maine DEP Nonpoint Training Center will discuss various causes for poor conditions on gravel roads, the importance of Best Management Practices, erosion control methods and the impact poor management has on aquatic resources. John will recommend practices for creating stable road conditions that minimize impact to nearby waterbodies including road crowning, surface materials, diversions, ditch stabilization and a few unconventional approaches. After the morning discussion there will be site visits to some well-designed road sites and nearby areas of concern.
